**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROCUREMENT
ACTIVITY OF CONSULTING SERVICES TO PROVIDE FOR THE
SYSTEM DEVELOPMENT OF THE PERSONAL PROPERTY SECURITY
REGISTRY (PPSR)**

1. The *Land Registration Authority*, through the General Appropriations Act for FY 2024 intends to apply the sum **TWELVE MILLION PESOS ONLY (PHP 12,000,000.00)**, inclusive of VAT, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Procurement of Consulting Services of the System Development of Personal Property Security Registry (PPSR)** with **Project ID No. LRA SPBAC-2024-02**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The *Land Registration Authority* now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for **Procurement of Consulting Services of the System Development of Personal Property Security Registry (PPSR)**. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the SPBAC Secretariat on or before **07 February 2024, 9:30 AM** at the **Property and Supply Section, Lower Ground Floor and/or 4th Floor Conference Room, LRA Building, East Ave., Diliman, Quezon City**. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion.

Opening of eligibility documents shall be on **07 February 2024 at 10:00 AM**, at the LRA Conference Room and via video conferencing via Zoom, with the following details:

Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend the activity.

3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the *Land Registration Authority* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours **8:00 AM to 4:00 PM**.
4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by the shortlisted bidders upon the Issuance of the Notice of Eligibility, from the address below *upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Twelve Thousand Pesos (PHP 12,000.00)*.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Shortlisted Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The SPBAC shall draw up the shortlist of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The shortlist shall consist of *three (3)*² prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

Applicable experience of the consultant and members in case of joint ventures, considering both the overall experiences of the firm or, in the case of new firms, the individual experiences of the principal and key staff, including the times when employed by other consultants	30%
Qualification of personnel who may be assigned to the job vis-à-vis extent and complexity of the undertaking	60%
Current workload relative to capacity	10%

6. The Bidders shall be selected and employed in accordance with the Quality Based/Selection Evaluation (QBE/ QBS) procedures as described in the Bidding Documents.
7. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, cooperatives, and partnerships or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
8. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the *Quality Based Evaluation/ Selection (QBE/QBS)* procedure. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.
9. The contract shall be completed within *three (3) months of development up to live deployment, and shall provide one (1) year support and fix all system bugs identified.*
10. The **Land Registration Authority** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
